**Where did sin come from?**

- **Romans 5:12** *Therefore, just as THROUGH ONE-MAN SIN ENTERED THE WORLD,*
- **1 Cor. 15:21,22** *For since BY MAN came death,*

**But wasn't there sin before that?**

- **Gen 3:1** *NOW THE SERPENT WAS MORE CUNNING*

**How do we know who this serpent is?**

- **Rev. 12:9** *So the great dragon was cast out, THAT SERPENT OF OLD, called the Devil and Satan, who deceives the whole world;*
- **John 8:44** *You are of your father the devil, and the desires of your father you want to do. He was a murderer FROM THE BEGINNING,*
- **1 John 3:8** *He who sins is of the devil, for the devil HAS SINNED FROM THE BEGINNING.*

**How did Satan fall?**

- **Ezekiel 28:13** says this, *YOU WERE IN EDEN, the garden of God;... 14 "You were the anointed cherub... 15 You were perfect in your ways from the day you were created, TILL INIQUITY WAS FOUND IN YOU... 17 "YOUR HEART WAS LIFTED UP because of your beauty; YOU CORRUPTED YOUR WISDOM for the sake of your splendor;*

**What did Eve do and Adam do?**

- **Gen 3:6** *So when the woman saw that the tree ..., SHE TOOK OF ITS FRUIT AND ATE. She also gave to her husband with her, AND HE ATE.*
  - SCRIPTURE places the primary \_\_\_\_\_ for this act on Adam, since Adam, WAS THE REPRESENTATIVE HEAD OF HUMANITY.

### Who does God call in the garden, Adam or Eve?

- **Gen. 3:9** “*But the LORD God called to Adam and said to him, ‘Where are you?’*”
- **1 Tim. 2:14** “*And Adam was not deceived, but the woman being deceived, fell into transgression.*”
- **Gen. 3:11**, Have you eaten of the tree of which I COMMANDED YOU not to eat?”
- **Romans 5:12** *THROUGH ONE-MAN SIN ENTERED THE WORLD*
